



SAFE Walk A Mile In Her Shoes® Frequently Asked Questions

Your support whether walker, spectator or contributor, is appreciated.

Q: When and where is Walk A Mile In Her Shoes®?

A: Walk A Mile In Her Shoes® will be held on October 13, 2017. Registration begins at 5:30 at the corner of Main St. and 3rd St in Hamilton. The Walk will begin at 6:00 pm. You can also register at www.safeinthebitterroot.org

Q: Do I have to wear high heels?

A: No. Wearing high heels is optional; supporting the event is the most important part.

Q: Can only men walk?

A: No! The purpose of the event is to raise public awareness about the prevalence of domestic and sexual violence in the community.

Q: What does it cost to participate in Walk A Mile In Her Shoes®?

A: Registration is \$25 for adult walkers, \$15 for youth walkers, and kids under 12 walk free. Registration includes an event t-shirt.

Q: How do I register for Walk A Mile In Her Shoes®?

A: Complete the registration form and send or e-mail to SAFE. You can also bring your registration form to the walk on October 13.

Q: Do I have to register before the event?

A: No. While SAFE would prefer you register early you can register at the event.

Q: Can teams enter?

A: Yes! On the registration form you can add your team name.

Q: I can't be at the walk but I want to support the cause. How do I make a contribution?

A: Donations can be made to SAFE on our website (www.safeinthebitterroot.org) or mailed to us (PO Box 534, Hamilton)

Q: Do I have to raise additional funds to participate?

A: No-but we ask that every participant *consider* raising funds for SAFE as part of the event. Ask your friends, family, and coworkers to make a pledge while you walk in the event. There is a pledge sheet attached to the registration form for you to use to gather pledges.

Q: How are the funds raised at Walk A Mile In Her Shoes® used?

A: SAFE's Walk A Mile In Her Shoes® event is one of our fundraising events that support SAFE's operating costs. Funds raised will help us continue to offer housing, services and community programs with the goal of creating a future free of violence.

Q: Do I have to provide my own shoes?

A: Heels in men's sizes will be available at the event while supplies last. Please note that you may want to go up a half size or full size from your normal shoe size since women's heels tend to have a more narrow toe box than men's dress shoes. Come early to choose your favorite. If you have your own heels feel free to wear them!

Q: What if I can't find shoes that fit?

A: If we can't find high heels that fit you can wear regular shoes or decorate an old pair of shoes ahead of time.

Q: If I bring my own shoes is the registration fee lower?

A: No. The registration fee is \$25 for adult walkers, \$15 for youth walkers, and free for kids under 12 regardless.

Q: Do I really have to walk a mile?

A: The course route is approximately one mile but we realize not everyone will be able to complete the entire distance. Feel free to leave the route and meet us at the Bedford Building (City Hall), where the walk will end. We ask that every participant give it their best shot!
