

# How SAFE is meeting those needs:

#### **Emergency Shelter**

- 43 adults & 29 children served
- 3508 nights of housing provided
- Average stay: 50 days

based on survivor requests

• Average occupancy: 119%

#### **Rapid Rehousing**

- 16 adults & 11 children served
- 3795 nights of housing provided

#### **Transitional Housing**

- 14 families & 25 children served
- 8813 nights of shelter provided
- Average stay: 16 months
- Average occupancy: 96%

#### **Children's Services**

- 629 hours of childcare provided
- 95% increase from 2021
