OUR GROWTH

SAFE broke ground on our shelter expansion project in September, 2023. This \$3.2M remodel will more than double our current emergency shelter and programming space.

The number of adults and children served by SAFE's community dinners and support groups this year was the largest since before the pandemic and is growing by the week.

This year SAFE's crisis phone line received 565 calls from people in our community seeking resources and support.

This is more calls in one year than SAFE has ever received and is **173 more** calls than the average over the last 5 years.

EMERGENCY SHELTER

3407 nights of shelter provided

Average stay: 36 days

Average occupancy: 117%

Over the last 5 years, SAFE has had to turn away more than 40 people on average each year due to lack of shelter capacity.
